

As a child in the 1980s, I got an edition of this book that was printed during Ronald Reagan's 1st term. It was very well organized, telling when each President up to that point was born & died, when & whom he married, who his parents, siblings & children were, who his Vice President & Cabinet officers were, & myriad other details. In the 30+ years (at this posting) since that edition, Presidents Nixon, Ford & Reagan have died. This latest edition does give the circumstances surrounding Reagan's death but barely mentions the death dates of Nixon & Ford. Also, in the chapter for John Quincy Adams, the "Father" paragraph still gives the outdated stat of the Adamses being the "only" father-&-son Presidents; someone failed to update that bit after George W. Bush took office. Still, all in all, this is a good reference book for any Presidential trivia buff from casual to die-hard.
